

Poster page size: 11 wide x 17 high or 17 wide x 11 high, either way.

Follow these rules when designing Poster:

If your Poster has bleeds, meaning background will print to the edge of the page, (Black rule), then you HAVE to Build in Bleeds, meaning image has to go .125 past edge of page, (Yellow rule). So then your page size would be 11.25 wide x 17.25 high or 17.25 wide x 11.25 high.

If your Poster has no bleeds, than your page size will just be 11 wide x 17 high or 17 wide x 11 high.

RED Rule is .125 inches in from edge of paper. That is where the text should start. Or that's the closet your text should be to the edge of the paper. THIS APPLIES TO ALL POSTERS. Whether the poster has bleeds or not. Always start your text at least .125 in from the edge of the paper size.
